# Sure-Seal Root <sup>™</sup>

#### Root Canal Sealing Material

#### Description

 $\textbf{Sure-Seal Root}^{\text{TM}} \text{ is a convenient premixed ready-to use, injectable calcium aluminosilicate paste developed}$ for permanent obturation of the root canal. Sure-Seal Root™ is based on a calcium aluminosilicate composition, which requires the presence of water to set and harden.

Sure-Seal Root<sup>™</sup> does not shrink during setting and demonstrates excellent physical properties.

### Setting time

Setting time is 25min. measured according to ISO 6876:2012 (100% humidity condition). However, in normal root canals, the setting time can be more than 2.5 hours.

#### Composition

**Indications** 

Calcium Aluminosilicate Compound, Zirconium oxide, Filler and Thickening agent

Permanent obturation of the root canal.

#### **Recommended Procedure**

- 1. Prepare and irrigate the root canal using standard endodontic techniques.
- 2. Remove the syringe cap from Sure-Seal Root™ syringe . Securely attach a disposable intra canal tip with a clockwise twist to the hub of the syringe. The disposable tip is flexible and can be bent to facilitate access to the root canal.
- Insert the tip of the syringe into the root canal no deeper than the coronal one third(1/3). Gently and smoothly dispense Sure-Seal Root<sup>™</sup> into the apex of the root canal.
- A radiograph can be taken at this stage to ensure an adequate apical seal. If the placement is not sufficient, thoroughly irrigate Sure-Seal Root <sup>™</sup> out of the root canal and repeat the procedure .
- 4. Continue filling the root canal with Sure-Seal Root ™ while withdrawing the disposable tip. Fill the root canal completely; avoid the formation of air bubbles and overfilling of the root canal.

  5. Remove excess Sure-Seal Root ™ from the top of the root canal with a moist cotton pellet.
- 6. Place the Gutta-Percha Points into the root canal using standard endodontic techniques.
- 7. Sure-Seal Root™ will remain part of the permanent root canal filling.

### Precaution & Storage

- 1. Avoid exposure to direct sunlight,
- 2. Store in a cool place.
- 3. For dental use only.
- 4. It should be used by a dentist and dental professional. Observe the procedure and the precautions.
- 5. Keep it away from a reach of non-dental users including children, senior citizens and others.
- 6. Do not overfill beyond the apex.

- 7. Do not press paste with excess force, or the patient may have some acute pain.
- 8. In accidental contact with eyes occurs, flush immediately with a large amount of water.
- 9. Please keep the syringe cap tightly when not using.
- 10. Do not reuse the disposable tip after use.
- 11. Do not use as an internal medicine
- 12. Do not use after expiry date.
